

# PUBLIC NOTICE

The City Council will hold a Public Hearing at 7:00 p.m. at its scheduled Council Meeting on Tuesday, August 16, 2016 in Council Chambers, Fourth Floor, Municipal Building, 427 Patton Street, Danville, Virginia.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to provide all interested parties an opportunity to speak to the City's intent to make application to the Federal Transit Administration through the Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation for financial assistance for the City of Danville Transit System for FY 2017. The amount of the City's application for federal operating assistance is \$723,306 and a total of \$1,206,463 in federal capital assistance is requested to finance the construction of a new administrative building and parking lot. Capital aid would also finance sidewalk and landscaping improvements and a passenger shelter for a new bus stop location on Enterprise Drive. In addition, federal capital aid would provide funding to acquire a dump truck, shelter for the trolley buses, token rolling machine and photocopier.

The proposed Program of projects will be adopted as the Program of Projects. In the event the proposed Program of Projects is amended as a result of the Public Hearing, the amended Program of Projects will be adopted.

Copies of the grant applications and the proposed expenditures are available for public review at the Danville Regional Airport.
