

# PUBLIC NOTICE

The City Council will hold a Public Hearing at 7:00 p.m. at its scheduled Council Meeting on Tuesday, September 5, 2017 in Council Chambers, Fourth Floor, Municipal Building, 427 Patton Street, Danville, Virginia.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to provide all interested parties an opportunity to speak to the City's intent to make application to the Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation for financial assistance for the City of Danville Transit System for FY 2018. The amount of the City's application for federal operating assistance is \$987,790 and a total of \$767,640 in federal capital assistance is requested to finance the following capital projects; rehabilitate facility parking lots, complete sidewalk improvements and erect a bus shelter for the Adult Education bus stop, obtain signage for new bus service, replace a coin counting machine, construct a propane refueling station, purchase radio equipment, replace five small buses and two support vehicles.

The proposed Program of projects will be adopted as the Program of Projects. In the event the proposed Program of Projects is amended as a result of the Public Hearing, the amended Program of Projects will be adopted.

Copies of the grant applications and the proposed expenditures are available for public review at the Danville Regional Airport.
