



## **Illicit Discharges Are Illegal.**

Illicit discharges are generally any discharge into a storm drain system this is not composed entirely of stormwater. Illicit discharges are a problem because, unlike wastewater which flows to a wastewater treatment plant, stormwater generally flows to waterways without any additional treatment. Illicit discharges often include pathogens, nutrients, and various toxic pollutants. Anyone responsible for an illicit discharge may be guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor.

### **Please Be Responsible.**

Don't dispose of waste into a storm drain. Never pour anything into or discharge anything to a storm drain. Never store liquids or soluble products near a storm drain. And if you witness a suspected illicit discharge or observe water pollution, report it.
