

# PUBLIC NOTICE

The City Council will hold a Public Hearing at 7:00 p.m. at its scheduled Council Meeting on Tuesday, July 2, 2019 in Council Chambers, Fourth Floor, Municipal Building, 427 Patton Street, Danville, Virginia.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to provide all interested parties an opportunity to speak to the City's application to the Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation for financial assistance for the City of Danville Transit System for FY 2020. The amount of the City's application for state operating assistance is \$487,325 and federal operating aid for \$1,213,756. Also, state operating aid is requested through the state's Senior Transportation Assistance Program in the amount of \$20,000 to support Danville's coordinated senior transportation operation with the Southern Area Agency on Aging. A total of \$124,868 in state capital assistance and \$624,332 in federal capital assistance is requested to finance the following capital projects; purchase three 14, passenger buses, two, 20 passenger buses and improvements to the transit system's propane refueling station. Related improvements to the propane station include the addition of a second fuel dispenser, canopy and the use of a fuel management system.

The proposed Program of projects will be adopted as the Program of Projects. In the event the proposed Program of Projects is amended as a result of the Public Hearing, the amended Program of Projects will be adopted.

Copies of the grant applications and the proposed expenditures are available for public review at the Danville Regional Airport.
