The Scarecrow Spectacular is part of the Harvest Moon Festival
at Ballou Park from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. on October 14, 2023

How do I enter a display?

- Contact Emily at (434) 857-3384 or use the link below to enter a display. There is no fee to participate.

What is the deadline to register an entry?

- Friday, October 6 at 5 p.m.

What size is the display space?

- Each participant gets a 6x6 space in Ballou Park.

When can I set up my scarecrow?

- Wednesday, October 11.

When do I take down the scarecrow?

- Scarecrows must be taken down by Saturday, October 21.

Who can create a scarecrow?

- Any individual, business, or organization can build a display.

Do scarecrow displays have to be homemade?

- Displays can be purchased or homemade. Inflatables are not allowed.

What do the scarecrow frames need to be made out of?

- Be creative! Fake skeletons, PVC pipe, wood, etc. Google and Pinterest have a lot of options for the novice scarecrow builder.

Do the scarecrows have to be stuffed with hay?

- The scarecrows in the display can be stuffed with any soft material. (Hay, rags, newspaper, etc.)

How many scarecrows can I put in my display?

- You can create a scarecrow scene with several scarecrows or just do one. Everything must fit in the 6x6 space.

How will scarecrows be voted on?

- People attending the Harvest Moon Festival will walk through the Scarecrow Spectacular and vote on their favorite display.
