Please Be Responsible.

Use fertilizers sparingly. Sweep fertilizer off of you driveway and sidewalk and put it back on your lawn. Use fertilizers with low or no phosphorus. Don't fertilize before a rainstorm. Recycle grass clippings by leaving them on your lawn to provide a natural fertilizer.
